<i>INTERMENT FEES (excluding all charges for labour)</i>	
For any interment in any earthen grave, walled grave or vault of the body of:	
(a) a stillborn child, or a person whose age at the time of death did not exceed 12 years	40.00
(b) a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 12 years	70.00
 <i>EXCLUSIVE RIGHT OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVES (99 years)</i>	
For the exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave 9 feet by 4 feet	95.00
Re-open a grave for burial of ashes	45.00
 <i>WALLED GRAVES AND VAULTS</i>	
For the right to construct including the exclusive right of burial therein	
(a) a walled grave 9 feet by 4 feet	220.00
(b) a vault 9 feet by 8 feet	440.00
 <i>MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES, TABLETS AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS</i>	
For the right to erect or place a headstone not exceeding 2' 6" in height	55.00
A further inscription after the first on a gravestone or monument	25.00

Flat stones, footstones, kerbstones/border stones and separate vases for new burials are not be permitted

GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE

PURCHASE OF PLOT AND ERECTION OF MARKER (99 years)	55.00
(Reservation of plot £20 with balance to be paid on interment in accordance with the prescribed fee at that time)	

SCATTERING OF ASHES and COMMEMORATIVE PLAQUE ON WALL (withdrawn due to lack of space for scattering ashes)

The foregoing fees, payments and sums will be doubled where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted is or was immediately before his death, not an inhabitant or parishioner of the Parish of Witcham, or in the case of a stillborn child, where neither of the parents is, or was at the time of interment, such as an inhabitant or parishioner, providing that the foregoing fees, payments and sums shall not be so double in the case of a person who has been an inhabitant or parishioner of the said parish at any time during the five years immediately preceding the date of death.

At a meeting of the Parish Council of Witcham, Cambridgeshire held this 14 day of March 2006, the above fees, payments and sums are hereby fixed and settled by the said Parish Council, with effect from 1 April 2006
